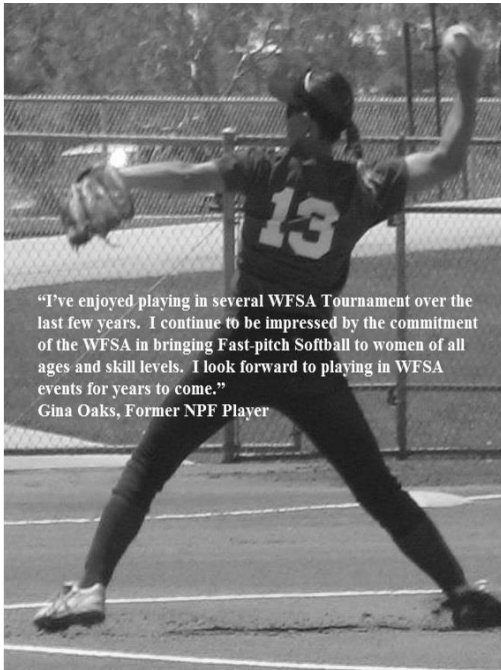


## About the WFSA

## WFSA Participant Contract

### For Your Piece of Mind

Each participant in the WFSA must complete an online Participant Contract to be able to compete in the WFSA. These contracts set forth very specific guidelines for the participants'ion of each individual.

The WFSA believes it is important to point out some of the more pertinent parts of the contract. If you wish to review a complete contract, please feel free to ask the local League President for a copy, or call the National Office, and a copy will be sent to you promptly.

#### *What you need to know about the WFSA Participant Contract:*

- The participant agrees not to possess or consume any alcoholic beverages or drugs at any time on the playing field, dugouts, bleachers, or other areas near or around the playing field facility...
- The participant agrees not to participate in fighting, physical abuse of players, umpires, or spectators.
- The Participant agrees to abide by local facility rules and regulation.
- The participant understands that the WFSA, in its sole discretion reserves the right to refuse any player or team permission to play in any WFSA league.
- The participant agrees to and understands that violation of any part of the contract may result in...forfeiture of games, suspension from play, fines or permanent expulsion from the WFSA.
- The participant...understands that they have total responsibility for any personal injury, accident, illness...while participating in any WFSA function...
- Additionally, a waiver of liability is part of each contract and is signed by each participant

### Money for Your Softball Program

#### What can the WFSA can do for you?

- Contribute to your program in the form of cash or goods (uniforms, softballs, bases, field repair, etc.) whichever you prefer.
- Help, through responsible weekend use, in keeping renegade, vandals, gangs or others intent on causing damage off your field.
- Help with field maintenance; Using your equipment or our own, we'll help keep your field in good playing condition and free of trash/debris.

## Insurance Coverage

The WFSA carries a \$2,000,000 liability insurance policy covering general liability and umbrella/excess liability insurance which will cover your organization and their employees for liability arising from any use of a facility or participation in any sporting activity. A copy of the insurance policy naming your facility (school, park district, ect.) will be provided for your records.
